1999 Sailing Season Ends with Close Finish in Flying Scot Championship Series

Dan Goldberg edged Paul Rowan by less than one point in the 13 week Championship Series in the Flying Scot class. There were 24 Scots registered for the series. Dan and Paul each scored four first places finishes along with many other high finishes. Paul was slightly ahead until the last race on the last day when Dan's 2nd place was enough to win the series.

Bob Gelman finished a close third and Dave Bishop was fourth in his first year as a Scot captain. Wolf Goethert rounded out the top five.

Gerry Brandt was the clear winner in the Championship Open class sailing his Sunfish. Dan Vito's Flying Dutchman took 2nd and Jim Hastings was third in his Day Sailor.

In the seven week Challenger series Dave Green came out on top in a Catalina 22. Second place went to Joe Kirk in a Catalina 22

with Bob Boyles rounding out the top three in a Flying Scot.

Bill Tingle won the End o' Summer Regatta on September 11th with Wolf Goethert coming in second and Ray Williams in third.

The Women's Sunfish Regatta II was also held on the same day. Unlike the first regatta in June the women had plenty of wind this time. Missy Hare traded a first and second with Sara Zavos in the first two races. In the third and final race, Missy overtook Sara on the last leg for the women's Sunfish championship. Sara won second place with Jean Rowan taking third. Stacey Beggs won a commendable fourth place after just learning to sail a few weeks earlier.

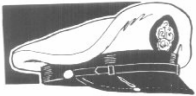
